

## Description of architectural accessibility of buildings

### Conradinum Ship and General Education Schools, 3rd Branch of Gdansk Bursa - locations where Gdansk Business Week 2020 will be held

#### Location and access

The buildings of SOiO Conradinum and Bursa Gdańska are located in their close neighbourhood on Piramowicza Street, close to Zwycięstwa Avenue in Gdańsk Wrzeszcz.

The closest (140 metres) to them is the tram stop: POLITECHNIKA 02, which can be reached by means of a ground crossing without traffic lights. The difference in height on footpaths does not exceed 4 centimetres.

The nearest stop of the SKM Politechnika SKM Municipal Railway is equipped with a lift to make it easier to get from and to the platform.

The route from SKM railway stop to the boarding house and school is 650 m long and forces a double crossing of side streets at pedestrian crossings without traffic lights. The difference in height on pedestrian crossings does not exceed 4 centimetres.

#### SOiO Conradinum building

In front of the entrance to the building there is a gate with a passageway 86 centimeters wide, behind it high stairs (10 steps, 17 centimeters high each) with, hard to reach, handrails. The entrance door is 90 centimetres wide. There is the inner staircase (11 steps, each up to 17 centimetres high) with handrails on both sides and a second pair of doors 75 centimetres wide.

The school exit to the car park and the green area has stairs with three steps of 15 centimetres each, without handrails.

Communication between floors is provided by two staircases, each with stair steps up to 15 centimetres high and at least one resting place and handrails. **There is no lift in the building.**

The passage between the historic part of the building and the right wing requires a passage 5 stairs 15 centimetres high with railings.

The entrance to each classroom has a single-leaf door - that is more than 90 centimetres wide. Each of the classrooms is marked and described in black. The handles are less than 90 centimeters high. The height of tables in classrooms is over 70 centimeters. Chairs with backrests are without armrests.

On each floor of the building there are separate toilets for men and women, none of them is adapted to the needs of people with disabilities.

The connecting link to the bursa building has doors over 90 centimetres wide and steep stairs (9 steps, 17 centimetres each).

### **The Building of Bursa**

In front of the entrance to the building there is a heavy gate with a passageway 86 centimetres wide and stone stairs (5 steps 14 centimetres high each) with handrails on both sides.

The front door are heavy, 76 centimeters wide. Behind them there are stairs (5 steps, 15 centimetres high each). Communication inside the boarding house may be hindered by anti-slip mats not hidden in the floor, protruding 2 centimetres.

Each of the rooms is accessed by single-leaf doors over 90 centimetres wide. Handles are less than 90 centimetres high.

Communication between floors is provided by a staircase with 25 stairs (each 12 centimetres high) with a rest and handrails. **There is no lift in the building.**

On each floor of the building there are separate toilets for men and women, none of them is adapted to the needs of people with disabilities.

### **Possibility of support**

If necessary, the organisers of Gdańsk Business Week will provide support for people with disabilities or reduced mobility. The scope and form of support will be agreed individually with the project participants.
